

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (4) of section 61 of the Goa, Daman and Diu Shops and Establishments Act, 1973 (Act 13 of 1974), the Government of Goa hereby exempts all the Information Technology units including Integrated information Technology Township, Information Technology Parks, Information Technology (IT) Companies, Information Technology Enabled Services (ITeS), Startup, Electronic Manufacturing Cluster (EMC), Industry 4.0. in the State of Goa, which are registered with Government of India under the Start-Up India programme and registered with the Start-Up Promotion Cell and IT Policy of Department of Information and Technology, Government of Goa, from the provisions of section 8, 10, 11, 16 and 50 of the said Act, for a period of 5 (five) years, from the date of publication of this Notification in the official Gazette, subject to the following conditions, namely:-

1. For the work done beyond 8 hours per day and 48 hours per week, the employee shall be entitled for overtime wages at double the ordinary rate of wages.
2. The employer/management is permitted to engage young person during the night shift, subject to provision of adequate security during the course of employment and to and fro transport from their respective residence.
3. Every employee shall be provided with weekly off.
4. The employee shall be provided with identity cards and all the welfare measures to which they are eligible as per the rules in force.
5. The registers and records prescribed under the Goa, Daman and Diu Shops and Establishments Rules, 1975 shall be maintained.
6. The exemption granted may be revoked at any time without any prior notice.

This Notification shall come into force with immediate effect.

- (1). Inspection shall be carried out of the establishment on a specific written or oral complaint made to the Inspector or any such Authority for violation of the provisions of the Act.
- (2). The employees shall be provided with all welfare measures to which they are entitled as per the provisions of the Act and the Rules in force.
- (3). The units exempted shall file Self Certificate of compliance of the provisions of the Act.
- (4). The exemption granted may be revoked at any time without any prior notice.

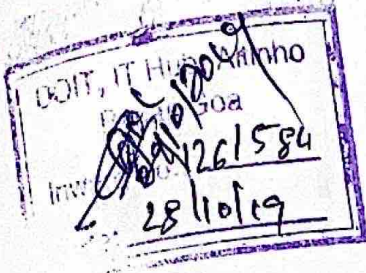

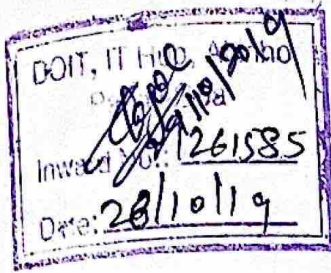


